How to get to There - Travelling from Bristol: Take the A37 to Farrington Gurney. Turn off onto the A362 towards Radstock. **Travelling from Bath:** Take the A367 towards Shepton Mallet and Wells. **From the West,** take the A39 and A37 to reach Farrington Gurney. Then follow the Bristol route above.

At Radstock follow signs to Frome. Go up the hill until you reach a pedestrian controlled crossing. Turn right, the school can be found a few yards along the road on the right.
