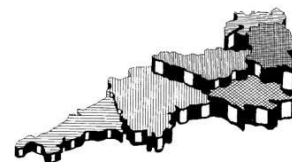

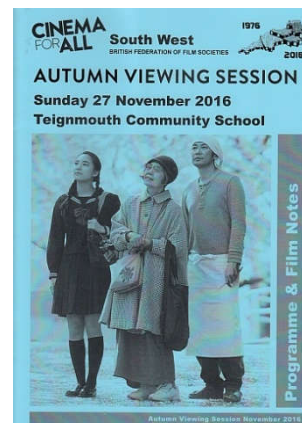
AUTUMN VIEWING 2016
